

CLEANING PROCEDURE FOR VIRAL OUTBREAK

Ensure before process begins that all staff have appropriate safety equipment, including gloves, eye protection, and disposable footwear.

HARD SURFACE CLEANING

Hard surface cleaning

- Fill clean trigger spray bottle with diluted bleach at 1:150 parts with clean water, this can be done through automated dispensing.
- Completely cover all surfaces concerned by spraying with diluted solution.
- Leave for at least 10 minutes, then rinse with fresh water.

Floors in kitchen, canteen, showers, bathroom, toilets (not carpeted areas)

- Fill clean bucket with diluted bleach at 1:150 parts with clean water, this can be done through automated dispensing.
- Using a clean (preferably new) mop, cover all surfaces and allow to dry for at least 10 minutes, then rinse with fresh water.

LAUNDRY

- Wash all linen on the Foul Wash / Infection Program for at least one week.
- It is important that all linen (especially contact linen such as bibs, sheets, etc.) be processed in this way for one week on the Foul Week / Infection Program.

DISHWASHER

- Descal the dishwasher and ensure the rinse temperatures are greater than 80 deg C.
- For manual washing, rinse all crockery and cutlery in bleach solution at 1:150 with water – **then DRAIN DRY do not towel dry.**

NOTE: Ensure all bleach kept for this application is replaced every 3 months.
